Case Highlights

- On September 4, a default order was entered against Ivan Cole assessing an administrative penalty of \$5,000 and suspending Respondent's boxer and second license for one year for failing to exhibit sportsmanlike conduct.
- On September 4, a default order was entered against Kick Ass Productions assessing an administrative penalty of \$1,000 for failing to provide a contestant with the proper information to file a medical claim.
- On September 16, a default order was entered against Rashid Abdullah assessing an administrative penalty of \$5,000 and suspending Respondent's contestant license for one year for failing to exhibit sportsmanlike conduct.
- On September 23, a default order was entered against Juan Serrano assessing an administrative penalty of \$500 for failing to carry out the terms and conditions of his contract concerning a combative sports event.
